Information for stallion owners who want to present a stallion for approval in 2023

SITES:

There will be at least three official stallion approval sites in 2023, in IL, CA and MD. Additional stallion inspections will be scheduled upon request.

Detailed information about these dates and possible additional stallion approval sites (which depend on the number and location of stallions nominated before April 1st) will be available at isreg@aol.com.

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS:

If you want to nominate a stallion please make sure to comply with the following requirements:

- a) Send in the completed nomination form
- b) and a copy of all original documents of the stallion (like **registration paper/proof of pedigree. Send proof of the Stallion-Test score sheet, show records**, if the stallion has already performed)
- c) Enclose a check of:
US\$ 400.-, if nominated before April 1st, 2023,
or US \$ 500.-, if nominated after April 1st, 2023

The payment of \$ 400.- or \$ 500.- is the fee for the official stallion inspection for ISR and Oldenburg NA. The inspection fee is non-refundable, even if the stallion does not show up.

After you nominated your stallion you will receive additional information regarding the inspection.

INSPECTION PROCEDURE

All stallions must be presented in hand, free schooling (trot and canter) and free jumping. Four years old and older must also be presented under saddle in walk, trot and canter. Three year old stallions can be presented under saddle as well which is strongly recommended. Stallions of four years and older will be asked to show lengthening of strides.

Exceptions may be granted for older and retired stallions with completed stallion test and / or sufficient performance records.

Scores will be given in three different departments: Conformation and type, Dressage Index (basic gaits and natural balance) and Jumping Index (capability, style and natural aptitude).

In order to receive an ISR-OLDENBURG N.A. Breeding License a stallion must have a total of at least 210 points with none of the indexes less than 65 points and no individual score less than 6.0 (scoring is on a 1 – 10 basis).

PAPERWORK

At the inspection the stallion owner must have all original documents (such as original paper, proof of pedigree, proof of Stallion Test, show records etc.) and one complete set of copies for the registry handy.

CERTIFIED BREEDING LICENSE

3yo – 6yo stallions which will receive a Certified Breeding License (limited license) in 2023 must attend a Stallion Performance Test (3-Day test under own rider) within two years or must provide sufficient show records for the Sport Test (see website for details or call) to receive the Lifetime Breeding License.

7yo and older stallions must have sufficient show records for the Sport test latest end of 2025.

*) For stallions which will not be presented under saddle (because of their age) each of the three basic gaits counts 30%, athletic ability and balance counts 10%.
