Enrollment & Waiting List Policy

The Galloping Lane Horsemanship Program is intentionally small by design. Our priority is the well-being of our horses and the quality of instruction we provide. To maintain a calm, safe, and supportive learning environment, enrollment in our program is limited.

Our Enrollment Philosophy

We believe that meaningful learning happens best in small numbers. Limiting enrollment allows us to:

- Protect the physical and mental health of our horses
- Provide individualized attention to each student
- Maintain a calm, unrushed learning environment
- Build genuine relationships with our students

Our goal is not to accommodate as many students as possible, but to teach well and responsibly.

Enrollment Availability

Enrollment is dependent on horse availability, instructor capacity, and overall program balance. Availability may vary throughout the year.

Galloping Lane Farm reserves the right to:

- Limit the number of active students
- Pause new enrollment at any time
- Determine appropriate placement for each student
- Decline enrollment if the program is not the right fit



Waiting List Policy

When the program reaches capacity, we maintain a waiting list.

The waiting list allows us to:

- Ensure fairness and transparency
- Maintain program quality
- Offer openings thoughtfully as space becomes available

Placement on the waiting list does not guarantee enrollment, but we make every effort to contact individuals as openings arise.

Priority Consideration

When openings become available, priority may be given to:

- Returning or existing students
- Students seeking consistent, ongoing instruction
- Individuals whose goals align closely with our horsemanship-focused philosophy
- Those able to commit to regular lesson schedules

Determining the Right Fit

Enrollment decisions are based on safety, horse welfare, and overall program fit.

Galloping Lane Farm reserves the right to decline or discontinue enrollment if we believe the program is not an appropriate match for a student's goals, needs, or expectations.

This decision is made thoughtfully and with respect, and always with the best interests of both horse and human in mind.

Changes to Enrollment Status

Enrollment status may change due to:

- Schedule changes
- Horse health or availability
- Program restructuring
- Safety or welfare considerations
